# A **Strategic Cabinet Workshop** was conducted where Cabinet members aligned on Botswana high income true north, and agreed on the priority sectors that will drive this target



- The session commenced with keynote addresses from the President and Vice President, outlining **Botswana's long-term economic vision and reaffirming the government's commitment to inclusive and sustainable growth.**
- Their remarks set the tone for the Cabinet Workshop, emphasising the **urgency of transformation and the need for bold, high-impact intervention**

- Following the keynote addresses, Cabinet members engaged in **structured deliberations to refine Botswana's High-Income Vision Statement** and identify key economic sectors for prioritisation.
- The discussions focused on aligning national aspirations with actionable strategies, informed by sectoral insights and economic impact potential
